


To All VSIP Retirees:

Stimulus Funding

With the passage of the most recent stimulus bill, transit funding for agencies nationwide will be about 14 billion dollars which is less than the 25 billion appropriated in the CARES Act in March of 2020. Based upon the federal guidelines and formula to distribute money; Metro can possibly receive between 600 and 900 million dollars to assist with Covid-19 related costs. We will keep you updated.
