Office of the Inspector General (OIG): Avoid at All Costs

As President, my responsibility is to not only provide the best representation as possible but have honest conversations with members when they could potentially create problems for themselves that can cost them time off from work without pay or the worst-case scenario: loss of employment: **FIRE!!!**

Periodically, we send reminders about investigatory departments making requests to meet with Supervisors and we advise all to request that your Union be present. One of those departments is the OIG, who investigate waste, fraud and abuse. We have had many instances where members have misused purchase cards (P-Cards), misappropriated time at work (shopping on duty, going home, misuse of company vehicles), wrongly claiming time worked when you've actually arrived late or left early, and other activities and behaviors while at work that would fall under the category of theft of time and resources.

Overtime has been an issue and will continue to be. If you have been afforded the opportunity to work overtime and you accept, please **WORK** the overtime opportunity assigned to you and make sure that your E-time reflects that. Failure to do so will initiate an investigation and the OIG will make a request to interview you. You do not want to be interviewed by them. They usually have all of the answers before they ask you questions.

Don't risk everything you've worked hard for by getting caught up with untruthful statements and negative actions.
